


Dear all,



UNIDO ITPO Italy works in close collaboration with its project donors - namely the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (MAECI) - Directorate General for Development Cooperation (DGCS), the Italian Agency for Development Cooperation (AICS), the Italian Ministry of Environment and Energy Security (MASE), and the Italian Friuli Venezia Giulia Region (FVG) – as well as its official partners in light of the signature of joint declarations and memorandums of understanding such as with Confindustria, Eni, Future Food Institute, CNH Industrial, University of Udine, Veneto Region and Acquedotto Pugliese - and all the different stakeholders in the framework of project activities and beyond.

The Office is very well-connected with the industrial sector of Italy and the members of the "Italian system" - among which SIMEST (Italian society for enterprises abroad) and SACE (Italian export credit agency) which are part of CDP Group (Cassa Depositi e Prestiti), as well as ICE/ITA (Italian Trade Agency) – and is always intensifying synergies and strengthening collaborations with relevant stakeholders from the institutional, private and academic sectors of Italy and developing countries such as ministries, embassies, regions and municipalities, investment promotion agencies, universities and more - in order to advance public-private partnerships for international cooperation.

DELEGATION FROM 9 PARTNER COUNTRIES





UNIDO ITPO Italy organized and assisted a ministerial, institutional and business delegation from 9 partner countries – namely Botswana, Cuba, Ethiopia, Iraq, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Morocco, Peru and Somalia – to the 2023 edition of Ecomondo, the Green Technology Expo, which took place in Rimini from 7th to 10th November 2023.

This initiative was organized within the framework of three UNIDO projects, namely: "Fostering international partnerships between companies and/or institutions operating in the Energy and Environment sectors" (#FIPEE); "Investment Promotion for Iraq - Phase II" (#IPI); and "Productive Sectors Development Program for Somalia".







Within the exhibition, UNIDO ITPO Italy took part as jury member, speaker and awarder in the award ceremony for innovative startups of the National Association of Young Innovators (ANGI).







The delegation was composed of more than 50 representatives of ministries, institutions and companies operating in the energy and environment sectors and beyond, who took part in more than 500 meetings with local exhibitors and visitors – also at UNIDO Italy's dedicated booth inside the fair – to discover new business opportunities and synergies for international collaborations.

Finally, UNIDO ITPO Italy was interviewed by AWorld for ActNow, the United Nations campaign to inspire people to act for the Sustainable Development Goals.





GMIS CONNECT TRIESTE ROADSHOW

POWERING SUSTAINABLE MANUFACTURING: THE RISE OF GREEN HYDROGEN



Press conference GMIS Connect Trieste 2023



A press conference organized by UNIDO ITPO Italy and World Trade Center Trieste was held on 29th June 2023 to announce that the Global Manufacturing and Industrialisation Summit (GMIS) would host its roadshow series in the city of Trieste in November 2023, to gather key industry leaders and experts from Italy to drive in-depth discussions around green hydrogen technologies, effective policies, and strategies to navigate the climate crisis in the context of manufacturing and beyond.

Co-chaired by the United Arab Emirates Ministry of Industry and Advanced Technology and UNIDO, GMIS brings together leaders from the global manufacturing and technology communities to discuss, debate, and shape the future of manufacturing.

The Summit aims to place manufacturing at the heart of economic regeneration and government policymaking and utilise technology as a tool for global cooperation and collaboration.

The event was attended by Ketty
Segatti representing the Friuli Venezia Giulia
Region, Chief Technical Advisor of UNIDO ITPO
Italy Dino Fortunato, Director of Confindustria Alto
Adriatico Massimiliano Ciarrocchi, and virtually
Namir Hourani, Managing Director of the Global
Manufacturing and Industrialisation Summit. Also
present at the panel were Rodolfo Taccani, Rector's
Delegate for Technology Transfer and Territorial
Relations for the University of Trieste (UniTS)
and Salvatore Dore, Contamination Lab (C-Lab)
Contact Person for UniTS.

During the press conference, all participants highlighted the significant achievements already made at the regional and local levels. The FVG Region has long been at the forefront of driving innovation, sustainability, and renewable energy with numerous initiatives aimed at developing international collaborations between universities and businesses. This remarkable track record led to its selection as the next venue for the GMIS Roadshow.

As part of the Region's green initiatives, the "YES! Call 2023 - Sustainable Innovative Solutions from Friuli Venezia Giulia" was also launched during the press conference.

The roadshow in Trieste

GMIS Connect Trieste "Powering Sustainable Manufacturing: The Rise of Green Hydrogen", the Roadshow of the Global Manufacturing and Industrialisation Summit organized by UNIDO and the Ministry of Industry and Advanced Technologies of the United Arab Emirates (MoIAT), was held on 14th November 2023 at the Friuli Venezia Giulia Region headquarters in Trieste, Italy.

The event – organized in collaboration with the FVG Region, UNIDO ITPO Italy, Confindustria, World Trade Center Trieste, University of Trieste, National Institute of Oceanography and Experimental Geophysics (OGS), the International Foundation of Trieste (FIT), and The Laboratory on Quantitative Sustainability (TLQS) – brought together thought leaders, government officials, and industry experts from Italy and the United Arab Emirates to highlight the opportunities in decarbonizing the manufacturing sector and the role of green hydrogen in powering sustainable manufacturing.





The conference opened with the welcome remark of the FVG Regional Minister for Environmental Defense, Energy and Sustainable Development H.E. Fabio Scoccimarro:

"I would like to stress the conviction and commitment of this Region to invest in green hydrogen not as utopian panacea, but as useful and essential component of such climate action portfolio

that all together, European and non-Europeans countries, public and private sector, we must implement to achieve what I believe to be our shared goal: to continue to have a performing industrial sector, and at the same time to develop an environment-friendly manufacturing that we morally must pass down to our future generations."



UNIDO ITPO Italy's Head Diana Battaggia commented during her speech:



The FIPEE Call Winners join 2023 GCIP Cleantech Days and IVECF

From 30th October through 3rd November 2023, the Winners of UNIDO ITPO Italy's "FIPEE Call for High Impact Cleantech" joined the Cleantech Days of the UNIDO Global Cleantech Innovation Programme (GCIP) and the International Vienna Energy and Climate Forum (IVECF) in Vienna, Austria.













Starting the week with the Opening Ceremony of the GCIP Cleantech Days, representatives of the winning SMEs of the FIPEE Call – Cubaenergía from Cuba, Happy Pads from Ethiopia, Drop Access from Kenya, and Ciclo from Peru – joined a training for entrepreneurs held by Siemens in Siemens City, during which they played the "Sustainability Game" by Siemens to promote cleantech and circular-economy business models in an innovative, dynamic way. After a pitch training session, on 1st November the delegates had the opportunity to perform a pitch about the sustainable competitive advantages of their innovative cleantech solutions to a jury of experts selected by UNIDO.

At IVECF, on 2nd and 3rd November, all Winners took part in the session "Connecting the dots to empower cleantech innovations & climate solutions". Notably, the Winner from Kenya Norah Magero, Co-Founder & CEO of Drop Access, also joined as panelist the sessions "Showcase of thematic solutions by women changemakers" and "Pathways to prosperity and climate neutrality".



2nd FIPEE Investment Forum on Energy & Environment

On 7th November 2023, within the context of the 2023 edition of Ecomondo – The Green Technology Expo in Rimini, UNIDO ITPO Italy held its "2nd FIPEE Investment Forum on Energy & Environment", as a milestone event towards the conclusion of the activities of the FIPEE project.

Opened by UNIDO ITPO Italy's FIPEE Project Coordinator Valentina Maltese and moderated by UNIDO ITPO Italy's Chief Technical Advisor Dino Fortunato, the panel session featured the participation as speakers – notably from the project donor and its local counterparts and major stakeholders – of: Carmen Cristina Terry Berro, Specialist Expert in Environmental Policies at the Ministry of Science, Technology and Environment of Cuba (CITMA); Tirhas Mebrahtu Hindeya, Director for Resource Mobilization and Project Monitoring Directorate at the Ethiopian Environmental Protection Authority; Zhuzim Daulet, Chief of the Waste Management Department at the Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources of Kazakhstan; Benedict Muyale, Senior Resource Mobilization Officer at National Environment Trust Fund (NETFUND) of Kenya; and David Toledano, President of the Moroccan Federation of Industries and Building Materials (FMC). The panel concluded with the closing remarks of Jacopo Betti from the project donor MASE, notably also attending the event.

The Forum represented an opportunity to showcase the results of the FIPEE project, highlight the latest policies on energy and environment currently in place in each partner country, and further foster the development of business synergies, also thanks to UNIDO ITPO Italy's wide ministerial, institutional and business delegation from the project's 7 partner countries at Ecomondo 2023.







FIPEE Call Business Day

On 6th December 2023 UNIDO ITPO Italy hosted online, on its Investment and Matchmaking Platform on Energy & Environment, the "FIPEE Call Business Day".

More than 20 participating companies had the opportunity to meet the 5 Winners of the "FIPEE Call for High Impact Cleantech", who introduced their innovative technologies already showcased at relevant international forums; exhibit their own technologies, products and services within the virtual expo space; discover products and services of all the international companies already registered on the online platform; and take part in B2B meetings, to discover new opportunities for investment, technology transfer and international partnerships.











At K.EY 2023 with a business delegation from Ethiopia and Kenya

At the 2023 edition of K.EY, held in Rimini from 22nd to 24th March, UNIDO ITPO Italy organized and assisted on site the participation of a business delegation in the energy sector from Kenya and Ethiopia.

Mostly focusing on and interested in the field of photovoltaic, solar panels and environmental technologies, the 6 companies – 5 Ethiopian and 1 Kenyan – had the opportunity to take part in more than 70 B2B meetings with Italian and international exhibitors at the fair, and reported to have identified innovative technologies and solutions to be replicated in their projects and home countries, paving the way for potential synergies and collaborations.







Business Forums in Jordan and Somalia

UNIDO ITPO Italy launched a roadshow to promote the two UNIDO Business Forums in Jordan and Somalia, which began with a kick-off event at UNIDO ITPO Italy premises in Rome on 27th March 2023 and continued with multiple roundtables and company visits across several regions and cities in Italy: on March 28th in Turin at FederCamere, March 29th in Reggio Emilia at Unindustria and Clevertech, March 30th in Bologna at Legacoop Emilia-Romagna and Ferrari Growtech in Mantua, and concluded on March 31st at Venicepromex and Genius Watter in Padua. These locations were identified based on the distribution of Italian regions with high industrial potential in the sectors of interest to the roadshow.



Opening with welcome remarks from the Head of UNIDO ITPO Italy Diana Battaggia and from Confindustria Assafrica & Mediterraneo Director General Letizia Pizzi, the kick-off roundtable of the roadshow notably featured the participation as delegates from Jordan and Somalia of Amin Alasoufi, Director of the Department of Economic Studies and Research at the Amman Chamber of Industry, and Abdullahi Mohamed Warfa, Senior Advisor to the Ministry of Commerce and Industry of Somalia.

Moderated by UNIDO ITPO Italy's Investment Promotion Expert Francesco
Pallocca and Chief Technical Advisor Dino Fortunato, the roundtable – also thanks to
ad hoc presentations by the two delegates – allowed to promote dynamic business
and investment opportunities in Jordan and Somalia to the multiple representatives
of the Italian business community also attending the roundtable, and further
consolidate business relations among Italy, Jordan and Somalia.



Within the framework of the IPI project, from 17th to 20th April 2023 UNIDO ITPO Italy took part in a mission to Baghdad.



SANA 2023

UNIDO ITPO Italy spearheaded the participation of the first-ever Iraqi delegation at the 35th edition of the SANA - International Exhibition of Organic and Natural Products held in Bologna from the 7th to the 9th of September 2023. The Iraqi delegation comprised not only 4 distinguished representatives from companies and institutions hailing from Iraq and the Kurdistan region but also included pioneers in the flourishing organic food industry and trade such as Rashi Al Fadhliyya.

Their presence marked a significant milestone in Iraq's journey towards economic revitalization and integration into the global market. Under the auspices of UNIDO ITPO Italy, the delegation was afforded an important platform to showcase their innovative products and cutting-edge services. Leveraging the dedicated Iraqi booth, crafted to encapsulate their diverse offerings, the Iraqi representatives seized the opportunity to exhibit their excellence to an international audience.

RiminiWellness 2023

UNIDO ITPO Italy supported the organization of the participation of the Design District Company, from the Iraqi Kurdistan region, in the 2023 RiminiWellness fair - the event that gathers all the main realities of the wellness universe - held in Rimini from 1st to 4th June. Design District Company is operating in the field of interior design and events organizing, founded by a group of expert women and located in Erbil since 2014, specialized in interior designing of buildings, houses, gyms, SPA's restaurants, tourism projects and now aiming to launch new initiatives on wellness and health care. In this framework, the two women representatives had the opportunity to take part in around 20 BtoB meetings with Italian companies and exhibitors at the fair mostly operating in the sectors of fitness and well-being, fostering opportunities for business and collaboration in the field between the two countries.




A twinning program between Jordanian and **Italian businesses**

On 19th January 2023 UNIDO ITPO Italy joined "A twinning program between Jordanian and Italian businesses", the event presenting the project "LevelUp - Advancing Jordanian Industries".

"Today, Italy and Jordan are in fact two countries that are confronted with similar economic issues such as unemployment, the need to advance industries, and the urgency to create decent job opportunities for both women and youth, including through self-employment" UNIDO ITPO Italy Head Diana Battaggia commented during her opening remarks.

This project allows those who may not yet have the level of competency required to thrive in the international markets, to participate actively in the technical work of standards development, and thus seize the opportunity to gain specifically targeted experience to promote women and youth-led investments in the selected value chains.

Regional Business Networking Forum and LevelUp Project Achievement

The "Regional Business Networking Forum and LevelUp Project Achievement" was held on 22nd and 23rd May 2023 in Amman, Jordan, under the patronage of the Ministry of Industry, Trade, and Supply (MITS) of Jordan in collaboration with the Union of Mediterranean Confederations of Enterprises (BUSINESSMED) and supported by UNIDO ITPO Italy.

The Forum brought together private sector companies from Italy and the vibrant Middle East and North Africa (MENA) region – including Egypt, Iraq, Lebanon, Palestine, and Syria – and served as a platform to foster B2B networking and best practices to reinforce export-oriented value chains for the industries of garment and fashion, food supplements and natural cosmetics, while presenting the achievements of the LevelUp project.



Numerous high-level actors in the field of international cooperation and institutional figures, including Excellencies, Ambassadors and Ministers from Italy and Jordan participated in the event, which also featured the closing remarks from the Head of UNIDO ITPO Italy Diana Battaggia:

«As UNIDO ITPO Italy, we remain committed to supporting Jordan's industrial development efforts, as well as in the entire MENA region to promote sustainable investments by boosting the competitiveness of SMEs.»

The Forum witnessed the participation of a delegation of 20 Italian entrepreneurs, particularly from the Friuli Venezia Giulia Region.

The delegation, led by Luisa Corbelletto, Coordinator of Sprint FVG, had the opportunity to discuss the business environment and opportunities to boost economic cooperation between the FVG-Triveneto Region, Italy, and the MENA region, as well as take part in numerous B2B roundtable sessions. Moreover, Giulio Tarlao, Coordinator of International Relations and European Programming

at the Autonomous Region of Friuli Venezia Giulia, and Letizia Pizzi, Director General at Confindustria Assafrica & Mediterraneo, also participated in the event as speakers.

Lastly, within the framework of the IPIraq project, 3 companies from Iraq – primarily from the governorates of Erbil, Dhi Qar, and Basra and operating in the sectors of agro-industrial production, infrastructure and construction, and renewable energies – were also in attendance.

The impact of this Forum is expected to be longlasting, fostering new business partnerships, increased trade, and economic growth in the MENA region. The LevelUp project continues to drive progress towards its goals of job creation, economic inclusion, and the development of a vibrant SME ecosystem in Jordan.



Final Ceremony of "Gate 4: Seed to Grow" Phase of UNIDO's LevelUp Program

On 9th March 2023, the final ceremony of the "Gate 4: Seed to Grow" phase of UNIDO's LevelUp Accelerator program was held in Trieste, Italy. The event marked the successful completion of the program's fourth phase, which focused on helping seven Jordanian startups grow and develop their businesses.

Delivered in partnership with Jordan's Ministry of Industry, Trade and Supply and local partners, including Change Labs, Jordan Exports, JEDCO, and Business and Professional Women Amman (BPWA), the LevelUp Accelerator program followed a fivegate selection process: "Gate 1: Call for Applications and Open Days", "Gate 2: Think Digital", "Gate 3: Incubation and Scale-up", "Gate 4: Seed to Grow", and "Gate 5: Go Global". The seven Jordanian SMEs had previously completed gates 1-3 of the LevelUp

Accelerator program, earning the designation of "Champions of Digital Change"; in the framework of the "Gate 4: Seed to Grow" phase, immersive industry training and fundraising boot camps took place at Polo Tecnologico Alto Adriatico Andrea Galvani, in Italy.

The final ceremony was attended by government officials of the Friuli Venezia-Giulia Region, business leaders, and representatives from UNIDO and its partner organizations. Delivering a keynote speech at the final ceremony, UNIDO ITPO Italy's Head Diana Battaggia recognized the achievements of participating SMEs in the Level Up program and urged them to continue to use the skills and knowledge gained during the program to drive their businesses forward.

Business Tour in Kazakhstan: focus on Urban Waste, Plastics, Metals and WEEE

UNIDO ITPO Italy organized an entrepreneurial mission to discover the Kazakh market in the sectors of recycling and treatment of urban waste, plastic, metals and WEEE, dedicated to Italian SMEs, held from 9th to 12th October 2023 in Almaty with the visit to various local public-private stakeholders.

Kazakhstan is the ninth largest country in the



world, having become one of the economic leaders of Central Asia in recent years. Growth based on industrial development programs that reflect the country's vision of sustainable environmental policies – including the Municipal Solid Waste Modernization Programme, which is still being implemented and which presents numerous business opportunities for Italian companies able to offer technologies and technical support in the sector of management, treatment and recycling of the main types of waste.



During the business tour in Kazakhstan, UNIDO ITPO Italy supported an Italian business delegation that had the opportunity to visit local public-private stakeholders operating in the reference sectors to learn about characteristics, regulatory frameworks and discover new business opportunities, meet Kazakh commercial and institutional counterparts in order to start possible international collaborations, and share good practices and made-in-Italy technological solutions with Kazakh counterparts to develop the local sector.

Mission to Kenya on geothermal for Italian delegation

UNIDO ITPO Italy coordinated a four-day mission to Kenya for an Italian business and institutional delegation in the geothermal sector, which took place from 27th to 30th March 2023.

After the "Italy-Kenya Business & Investment Forum on Geothermal" on 27th March, on the second day of mission the visits of the Italian delegation to several key geothermal sites in Kenya started in Menengai, at the 6 MW well and project infrastructure of the Geothermal Development Company (GDC) of Kenya and upcoming 35 MW plant by Sosian Energy, also experiencing different uses for geothermal energy including greenhouse farming, aquaculture and milk pasteurization.

The mission continued on 29th March at the Akiira geothermal site, where the Italian delegates had the opportunity to understand first-hand the local challenges related to the recovery and development of two deep geothermal wells, and at the Oserian Development Company, with its more than 250 hectares of greenhouses for the cultivation and distribution of flowers by the in-house company Bohemian Flowers.

On the concluding day of mission, the Italian delegates visited the Olkaria Geothermal Spa, followed by a presentation by the team of the Kenya Electricity Generating Company (KenGen) about their activities in terms of renewable energy, and finally with the tour of KenGen's geothermal power plants Olkaria I and V sites, the latter generating 170+ MW transmitted through and on-site 220 kV substation.

By promoting international cooperation and sharing know-how and best practices in the field, UNIDO ITPO Italy's mission to Kenya contributed to maximize the impact of geothermal energy power plants at local, national and global level, in order to harness the huge Kenyan potential in the geothermal, renewable energy sector and beyond, toward an Inclusive and Sustainable Industrial Development within the country, in line with the mandate of UNIDO and the United Nations 2030 Agenda.











The "Italy-Kenya Business & Investment Forum on Geothermal" was successfully held on 27th March 2023 with more than 120 participants at the Kawi Complex Auditorium in Nairobi, promoting the development of new synergies and collaborations in the field of geothermal and beyond between the private and public sectors of both countries.

The Forum was organized by UNIDO ITPO Italy with the financial support of the Italian Ministry of Environment and Energy Security (MASE) and in collaboration with the Ministry of Energy and Petroleum of Kenya, the Geothermal Association of Kenya (GAK) and Unione Geotermica Italiana (UGI), as a part of UNIDO ITPO Italy's mission to Kenya for an Italian business and institutional delegation in the geothermal sector.

Notably opening with the welcome remarks of GAK Chairman Paul Ngugi, Deputy Head of Mission at the Embassy of Italy to Kenya Lorenza Gambacorta, UNIDO ITPO Italy's Head Diana Battaggia, and Her Excellency the Ambassador of Kenya to Italy Jackline Yonga, the Forum featured the interventions of several high-level government and institutional guests, starting with the keynote address of Principal Secretary at the Ministry of Energy and Petroleum of Kenya Alex K. Wachira – who stressed on the importance for Kenya and Italy to further strengthen their existing relations in renewable energies and particularly in the geothermal sector, where new partnerships could be established – as well as UGI President Prof. Bruno Della Vedova, Vice President of the Italo-Kenyan Trade Association (CDCIK) Ashfaq Makrani, and GAK Vice Chairman Peketsa Mangi for the closing remarks.

"This Forum reflects the goals of the FIPEE project by facilitating investments, the transfer of skills and best practices, and policy dialogue to boost local markets for economic growth and energy cooperation" added UNIDO ITPO Italy's FIPEE Project Coordinator Valentina Maltese during her speech, before leaving the floor to UNIDO ITPO Italy's Expert in Energy and Environment for Kenya Linda Faith Okaalet in order to highlight UNIDO ITPO Italy's latest activities in support of the Kenyan geothermal sector.

During the main panel session of the Forum, many expert representatives of the major Kenyan stakeholders in the field — namely Managing Director and CEO of the Kenya Electricity Generating Company (KenGen) Abraham Serem, Paul Ngugi as Acting Managing Director of the Geothermal Development Company (GDC), Ag. Director Economic Regulation & Strategy at the Energy and Petroleum Regulatory Authority (EPRA) Dr. John Mutua, Director Geothermal of Akiira Geothermal Limited Dr. Stephen Onacha, and Director of Geothermal Training and Research Institute (GeTRI) at Dedan Kimathi University of Technology Prof. Nicholas Mariita — delivered technical presentations on geothermal energy in Kenya to provide the Italian delegation with a comprehensive overview of the local sector by illustrating its legal framework, main challenges and potential.



At the end of the first session of the Forum, a multilateral meeting was held among the Ministry of Energy of Kenya (Alex K. Wachira, Principal Secretary) the Ambassador of Kenya to Italy (H.E. Jackline Yonga) the Italian Embassy to Kenya (Lorenza Gambacorta, Deputy Head of Mission and Giacomo Montemarani, Commercial Attaché) and UNIDO ITPO Italy.

In the afternoon session of the Forum, the Italian enterprises introduced their innovative solutions and expertise to the Kenyan and international audience, paving the way for the following highly participated Q&A and networking sessions, during which all participants at the Forum had the opportunity to interact and discuss together opportunities for investment, business and collaborations.










Mission to Lebanon officially kicks off project to support Lebanese SMEs in the wine sector

The mission — which took place across the Lebanese cities of Beirut, Baabda, Kaslik — was carried out by an Italian delegation composed of representatives from UNIDO ITPO Italy, FVG Region and University of Udine, and featured a participated press conference (notably broadcasted on Lebanese television) to officially announce the project to the national audience and beyond, multiple meetings with relevant local stakeholders involved — namely the Lebanese Ministry of Industry, UNIDO Lebanon, the Italian Embassy to Lebanon and the Italian Trade Agency in Lebanon, the Chamber of Commerce of Zahle, the Association of Lebanese Industrialists, Union Vinicole du Liban (UVL) and the National Institution of Vine and Wine (NIVW) — as well as several company visits, further fostering public-private synergies to pave the way for upcoming activities in the framework of this project.





PlastExpo 2023 in El Jadida

UNIDO ITPO Italy took part in the 2023 edition of PlastExpo, the main exhibition in Morocco related to the green plastic sector organized by the Fédération Marocaine de la Plasturgie (FMC) and held in El Jadida from 7th to 10th June 2023. 5 selected Italian companies, thanks to the support provided by UNIDO ITPO Italy, had the opportunity to take part in the fair, attend B2B meetings with visitors and exhibitors, as well as to visit the Jorf Lasfar Industrial Park.

Notably, the Minister of Industry and Trade of Morocco Ryad Mezzour visited UNIDO ITPO Italy's booth at the fair, where the Italian companies had the opportunity to showcase their innovative technology to foster new business collaborations between Italy and Morocco.

Partnership between Moroccan FMC and Italian ANPAR signed during the seminar on construction waste management in Casablanca

In the framework of the seminar "The Italian Circular Economy applied to the Construction sector of Morocco" organized by UNIDO ITPO Italy, the signing ceremony of the collaboration agreement between FMC and ANPAR was held, who agreed to cooperate and exchange regularly information on: the organization of seminars, workshops, conferences of scientific and technological interest for the associations and the associates; the evolution of the legal and regulatory framework relating to the sectors of interest of the two associations; technical assistance activities to promote the adoption of good practices in the construction sector and the recycling of C&D waste; the introduction of measures to promote the principles and models of the green and circular economy in the construction and recycled aggregates sectors; and the development of technologies and solutions for greater respect for the environment and less soil consumption.

This agreement between FMC and ANPAR symbolizes a veritable milestone in the construction sector and will contribute to significantly strengthen the exchange of expertise and know-how between Italy and Morocco, so to concur to the creation of a circular supply chain in the Moroccan building industry, to disseminate opportunities for cooperation and socio-economic growth among SMEs, while responding to one of the country's most urgent environmental challenges, thus confirming that respect and safeguard of environment represent a crucial factor for economic growth and human development; today and for generations to come.

To conclude, it is worth mentioning also the meeting organized between FMC and ANPAR during Ecomondo 2023 exhibition in Italy, facilitated by UNIDO ITPO Italy, on post-seismic reconstruction in Morocco, with special reference to mountain villages damaged by the recent earthquake in the country in September 2023. The will of the Moroccan stakeholders, as discussed during the meeting with ANPAR and ASSOAMBIENTE, was to create a pool of Italian experts so to organize a preliminary mission onsite to evaluate needs and technical solutions to rebuild damaged buildings in accordance with local architectural tradition and modern anti-seismic standards.





High-level roundtable with Somali Minister of Commerce and Industry and H.E. the Ambassador of Italy to Somalia

On 13th February 2023 UNIDO ITPO Italy hosted a high-level roundtable meeting at the presence of His Excellency the Minister of Commerce and Industry of the Federal Republic of Somalia, Jibril Abdirashid Haji Abdi.

The roundtable started with the opening remarks of His Excellency the Ambassador of Italy to Somalia Alberto Vecchi, UNIDO Somalia Programme Manager Ygor Scarcia and Giuseppe Mistretta, Director for Sub-Saharan African Countries at the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, and was concluded by a participated Q&A session after the presentations of several Italian companies, institutions and associations operating in Somalia attending the roundtable in presence as well as online.

Notably, during his keynote speech the Somali Minister officially announced the second edition of the "Italia-Somalia Business and Trade Forum", taking place in Mogadishu on 30th and 31st May 2023 with the goal to further strengthen economic cooperation between the two countries for an inclusive and sustainable industrial development, and thanked UNIDO and ITPO Italy for their continuous support in this direction.

Macfrut 2023: UNIDO ITPO Italy and UNIDO Somalia support Somali delegation

At the 2023 edition of Macfrut, held in Rimini between 3rd and 5th May, UNIDO ITPO Italy and UNIDO Somalia supported the participation in the fair of a Somali delegation composed of local companies operating in the field of fruit & vegetables.

During the fair, the Somali delegates had the opportunity to meet exhibitors and visitors, discussing business and facilitating the development of potential collaborations. With their own dedicated booth at the fair, UNIDO ITPO Italy and UNIDO Somalia also took part in a panel session to introduce the delegation as well as upcoming activities to promote Somalia as a business destination for Italian and international companies – including the 2nd "Italia-Somalia Business & Trade Forum".









The 2nd edition of the "Italy-Somalia Business & Trade Forum", organized within the framework of the "Somalia Economic Conference" of UNIDO Somalia, was held in Mogadishu on 30th and 31st May 2023. Objective of the event was to promote Somalia as an emerging business destination for Italian and international companies, encouraging the development of synergies and collaborations in various focus sectors — such as agriculture, fishing, livestock, poultry, dairy and construction — in terms of trade, concession agreements, technology transfer and foreign direct investment. More specifically, UNIDO ITPO Italy supported the participation in the Forum of several delegates of Italian companies, who also had the opportunity to take part in informative roundtables, matchmaking and B2B sessions, and meet international partners to discover new business opportunities.

The conference welcomed more than 450 participants including high-level officials of the Somali government, both federal and member states, United Nations agencies, European Union representatives, Italian and international companies, the Somali private sector, associations and donors, marking a significant milestone in the promotion of business opportunities and international collaborations for the development of the Somali private sector. The Italian Ambassador in Somalia, His Excellency Alberto Vecchi, also joined the event as panelist and recalled the deeprooted relations between Italy and Somalia. «Italians», said the Ambassador, «when they come to Somalia they feel at home. This happens above all thanks to the hospitality of the Somali people and the special relationship they still maintain with



Workshop on Circular Economy for Municipalities

UNIDO ITPO Italy's "Workshop on Circular Economy in Municipalities" took place in Sancti Spíritus, Cuba, on 17th and 18th January 2023, with the goal to sensitize municipal stakeholders at both local and global level about the need to promote and transit towards the application of a circular economy model.

Attended by 32 public and private stakeholders, the workshop allowed to present the fundamental principles of circular economy, as well as its benefits for sustainable development; contextualize circular economy in municipal environments, identifying actors, opportunities and initiatives; and share success stories and best practices in the application of circular economy models in municipalities and cities worldwide.

The activity paved the way for a potential collaborative project to promote an interprovincial center of circular economy and industrial symbiosis.

Study mission on saline intrusion in Camagüey

From 23rd to 27th January 2023, UNIDO ITPO Italy organized an expert study mission to Cuba, with the goal to analyze the current situation and contribute to minimize the negative impacts of saline intrusion in the Cuban province of Camagüey.

The phenomenon of saline intrusion constitutes one of the fundamental environmental challenges of the country, exacerbated by climate change and with a dramatic impact on agricultural areas threatening the national food security. Field visits and expert meetings with representatives of the local counterpart, the National Institute of Water Resources (INRH) of Cuba, emphasized the need for an integrated solution to address water resource recovery, meet drinking water needs, and enhance environmental conditions for socio-economic development.

The Multi-Criteria Decision Making process identifies the IWRM solution #4 (new aqueduct from Najasa II dam + irrigation development) as the most effective despite higher costs and longer construction time, offering significant environmental and socio-economic benefits. While solution #2 (new aqueduct with well field closure) and #3 (irrigation development and artificial recharge) have merits, the immediate construction of a new aqueduct to Santa Cruz del Sur is crucial for urgently supplying safe water. Solution #3 is recommended for long-term perspective due to its delayed impact on drinking water issues. The total investment for IWRM solution #4 is 380,185,275.00 CUP, necessitating a phased approach. Urgently, a new aqueduct is proposed to utilize Najasa II dam water, connecting to well fields and mitigating saline intrusion and sanitary risks. The benefits include addressing health hazards, utilizing dam-stored water, and saving energy by halting well withdrawals.

In conclusion, the study emphasized the urgent need for immediate action, particularly the construction of a new aqueduct, while outlining the long-term potential of comprehensive IWRM solutions to address the complex water management challenges in the region.





Course for MSMEs on environmental management

On 6th and 7th June 2023 in Havana, Cuba, UNIDO ITPO Italy successfully held a course focused on sustainable environmental management dedicated to local MSMEs to sensitize about the importance of adopting circular-economy models for sustainable development in the country.

Thanks to the participation as panelists of multiple international experts from the Cuban Ministry of Science, Technology and Environment (CITMA) as well as from Area Science Park – on this occasion represented by its Director Massimiliano Rudella – the course introduced global environmental challenges, illustrated legal frameworks in the field, and presented business success cases – among which, the Winner from Peru of UNIDO ITPO Italy's FIPEE Call for High Impact Cleantech, Ciclo, with its CEO Roger Mori Pizzino showcasing its awarded innovative technology and sharing best practices with the Cuban MSMEs.







Ethiopian Study Tour and Delegation to Agrilevante fair

From 5th to 7th October 2023 UNIDO ITPO Italy assisted an institutional and business delegation from Ethiopia for a study tour on the water-energy-food sector in the Italian region of Apulia.

During the study tour, the delegation had the opportunity to visit CIHEAM Bari – the International Center for Advanced Mediterranean Agronomic Studies in Bari – to learn more about the institute's activities for smart agriculture and water efficiency, with visits to its insectariums and experimental fields, as well as to take part in Agrilevante – the International Exhibition for Machines, Plants and Technologies for Agriculture and Animal Husbandry – to meet local and international exhibitors and visitors to discover sustainable innovative technologies.





Study Tour and Trainings on Precision Forestry

UNIDO ITPO Italy coordinated and assisted on site a study tour on precision forestry a delegation from Ethiopia and Peru, held between 31st January and 2nd February 2 in Italy between Florence and Pistoia and carried out by Bluebiloba and the Depart of Agricultural, Food, Environmental and Forest Sciences and Technologies (DAGRI) the University of Florence.

At the Italian Academy of Forest Sciences in Florence, the delegation attended on January 31st an in-class training focusing on several topics, among which forest rem sensing and water harvesting management, interacting with the local experts as we each other to share views, raise questions and improve technical skills, through pra exercises on Google Earth Engine. On the second day, the study tour featured a spe session of augmented reality, during which all delegates experienced the use of a chainsaw and learned how to accurately use it for legal logging through technical to

On February 2nd, the delegates had the opportunity to visit the forestry site in the Apennines of Pistoia at the company Azienda Agroforestale Gaggioli Lorenzo. During visit, after discussing Italian regulations on how to deal with forest operations, tree and indigenous species, demonstrations were held and innovative measurement to including 3D applications – were given to the delegates for practical exercise.

Notably, the study tour concluded with the vote of thanks and delivery of attendan certificates to all delegates from Ernesto Fino, representing the Italian Ministry of Environment and Energy Security – donor of the FIPEE project - whose participation the activity was positively perceived as clear signal for further collaboration.

This initiative successfully allowed the Ethiopian and Peruvian delegates to establish linkages with key Italian experts belonging to universities, research centers and forest operators, as well as to learn more about and practice the use of technological tools for forestry management, conservation and restoration, paving the way for additional future trainings with Italian experts.











Use of Google Earth Engine for Analysis of Forestry Data

Organized by UNIDO ITPO Italy in collaboration with the University of Florence (UniFi), the webinar "Use of Google Earth Engine for Analysis of Forestry Data" took place online on 15th June 2023 at the presence of more than 40 companies and institutions from Ethiopia and Peru in the field.

With the special participation as key panelist of UniFi Professor Francesca Giannetti, the event illustrated into details how to effectively use the tools offered by Google Earth Engine — including key features such as data catalog, cloud-based computing, geospatial analysis, visualization and mapping, and more — in order to perform different analyses related to forestry data, sharing best practices for increased know-how and expertise with relevant stakeholders from Ethiopia and Peru, towards the development of the local sectors.



(a division of Energotec) Eng. Federico Solari; and representatives of the Convention Bureau and the Chamber of Tourism of the Sacred Valley of the Incas, as well as officials for environment management.

During the presentation of its study "Technologies and Solutions for Solid Waste Management", CIE Technología Ambiental addressed the challenges of the sector in Urubamba and its surrounding regions and detailed opportunities for solutions through sustainable best practices.

The transition to a circular-economy model is essential for an Inclusive and Sustainable Industrial Development in the province of Urubamba: in this direction, the study will now allow local authorities to evaluate concrete measures for actions against climate change, preserving nature by reducing carbon footprint and greenhouse gas emissions, as well as for the formalization of small family businesses through the creation of new jobs in solid waste collection.

Round Table for the presentation of the Study on Technologies and Solutions for Solid Waste Management in Urubamba

UNIDO ITPO Italy organized and held on 14th December 2023 at the premises of the Provincial Municipality of Urubamba, Peru, a presentation of the study on technologies and solutions for local solid waste management to promote sustainable practices in the field.

Moderated by UNIDO ITPO Italy's Chief Technical Advisor Dino Fortunato, the round table was open to and attended by local and national government authorities, professionals, academics and further stakeholders interested in waste management: among the participants, representatives of the Ministry of the Environment of Peru (MINAM), country counterpart of the FIPEE project; the Mayor of Urubamba, Eng. Rolando Vera Gallegos; the Representative of CIE Tecnología Ambiental





Study Tour on Industrial Zones in Jordan

Taking place in Jordan from 13th to 16th March 2023, the study tour for 10 Iraqi delegates from the Ministry of Industry, Industrial Zone Commission, Enterprise Development Centers and business associations was planned with the aim of presenting best practices and success stories in relation to the Jordanian model of industrial zones and introduce them to selected Jordanian institutions and associations to support small and medium-sized enterprises, the private sector and beyond.




On the first day of the study tour in Amman, the delegation met with Deputy General Manager of JIEC – Jordan Industrial Estates Company Oday Obaidat and Investment Director Kay Marwan Depolacky, who presented the 9 industrial zones of the country while exploring the business model and legal framework under which these zones operate in the country.

Afterwards, the delegation moved to the oldest industrial area of the country, on the outskirts of Amman, the Abdullah II Ibn Al Hussein Industrial Estate, where, following a meeting with the Director of the industrial area, visits were made to two successful companies in the area: Nabil Foods, specialized in the production of a wide range of frozen and refrigerated products, present on the retail market and supplier for many international restaurant chains; and Dip - Universal Drip Irrigation Pipe Manufacturing, a Jordanian company controlled and managed by Iraqis which has become an international excellence in the field of irrigation.

On the second day, the delegation was supported to visit the largest industrial area in the country, almost at the border with Syria: the Al-Hassan Industrial Estate in Irbid. Here, after meeting the Director of the industrial area, the study tour continued with visits to two major companies: Durra, a large Syrian company that produces a vast range of foodstuffs and fresh foods and employs almost exclusively female and largely Syrian employees in production; and Mobedco, a manufacturer of pesticides and veterinary drugs with historic production sites across various industrial areas in several Arab countries.

After visiting two of the main industrial areas of the country, on 15th and 16th March the study tour continued in Amman, focusing the attention on the main institutions, associations and supporting industry and innovative companies in the most strategic sectors of the country: among these, the Ministry of Industry, Trade and Supply, where the issue of policies in support of the Jordanian private sector and national import-export strategies was addressed; the Amman Chamber of Industry (ACI), a point of reference for the country's manufacturing industry; the Information and Communications Technology Association of Jordan - int@j, which develops interesting services trying to maximize the contribution of the ICT sector to the national economy; and finally Oasis500, the first accelerator of innovative companies of its kind in the MENA area, manager of pre-seed and seed funds which aims to catalyze the regional entrepreneurial ecosystem and to invest and enhance scalable innovative ideas and startups within the technological sectors.





TOE 19 Course at EDC Thi Qar

UNIDO ITPO Italy facilitated the organization of the Training of Entrepreneurs (TOE 19) held on 2nd August 2023 at the UNIDO Enterprise Development Center (EDC) Thi Qar in Iraq.

Featuring the attendance of 32 participants – among which notably many women entrepreneurs, the course enabled valuable knowledge exchange under expert guidance, offering extensive training in essential management and development subjects including business planning, communication, marketing, accounting, and financial record-keeping skills.









Ministerial Training Workshop in Iraq

In a concerted effort to bolster capacity-building and foster sustainable development in Iraq, UNIDO ITPO Italy participated in a transformative training workshop organized by the Ministry of Construction, Municipalities, and Public Works of Iraq held in Baghdad on the 12th and 13th of September 2023.

This event sought to equip governmental stakeholders with essential skills in business plan development and risk management, crucial elements for the successful implementation of projects aligned with national development objectives.

UNIDO's steadfast commitment to advancing inclusive industrialization and economic empowerment was exemplified by the presence of Dr. Abdulhadi Al-Hatem, UNIDO's National Technical Coordinator in Iraq, at the training workshop. Dr. Al-Hatem delivered comprehensive insights and practical guidance on the intricacies of business plan formulation and risk mitigation strategies, elucidating the fundamental structure and components of a robust business plan and emphasizing adherence to UNIDO's proven methodologies tailored to the Iraqi context. UNIDO's engagement provided participants with essential tools and frameworks to identify, assess, and mitigate risks effectively, thereby enhancing project resilience and sustainability.



Digital Strategy for SMEs: an Introduction to Navigating Iraq's Digital Economy

UNIDO ITPO Italy's webinar "Digital Strategy for SMEs: an Introduction to Navigating Iraq's Digital Economy" took successfully place online on 5th October 2023.

With the participation of around 40 Iraqi and Italian start-ups and SMEs, the webinar provided an introductory overview of key digital strategies for navigating the Iraqi market and, more specifically, its digital economy. By bringing together key local hubs, institutions, and firms with a focus on digitalization – with the participation as panelists of representatives of Baghdad Business School, The Station, Kapita, Abwaab, Hi Influencer, Aon and Baghdad Game Lab – to share presentations and success stories, the webinar allowed to create and strengthen existing networks that can support and empower start-ups and SMEs in their digital journey.





Finally, the last two days of the Bootcamp were held at the premises of the Geothermal Development Company (GDC) in Nakuru, focusing on both technical aspects of geothermal energy as well as on its social, economic and environmental impact on the local communities, for Inclusive and Sustainable Industrial Development, toward the achievement of UNIDO's mandate and the United Nations 2030 Agenda.




Launching Ceremony of UNIDO Global Call 2023

World Manufacturing Forum 2023

UNIDO ITPO Italy participated in the 2023 edition of the World Manufacturing Forum – the annual event where industry leaders, policy makers, academics and research innovators address and discuss current and future manufacturing challenges – held on 27th and 28th November 2023 in Bergamo, Italy at the premises of SDF Group, Italian company among the main world manufacturers of tractors and harvesting machines.

Two days on the theme "New Business Models for the Manufacturing of the Future" with keynotes, round tables and parallel events on the main trends driving the new manufacturing scenario and their impact on the redesign of manufacturing supply chains.
